ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE STEELE:

- 1. Receiver's motion for the approval of a sale transaction (a sale of real property).
- 2. The debtor requests a short adjournment on the basis that the Receiver's materials were short served. The debtor opposes the receiver's motion and wishes to file a factum. The receiver opposes the adjournment, as does the applicant creditor, Roynat Inc., and the creditor, MacEwen Petroleum Inc..
