ENDORSEMENT

[1] An application to appoint a receiver was returnable this morning at a 9:00 a.m. court. No documents had been filed by any party in opposition to the relief that is requested by the Applicant.

[2] Mr. Ennis, the principal of Metamore Inc. appeared and requested time to put alternative financing in place. It is acknowledged that approximately \$5 million is owed to the Applicant and under the Applicant's security instruments it has the right to put in a receiver. I further note that there was a previous receivership (Toronto Commercial List file no. CV-25-00735381-00CL) which was discharged on July 7, 2025.

[3] This matter is adjourned to March 17, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. on the following terms:

- a. The respondent Metamore Inc. will make a payment of \$57,000.00 to the Applicant by February 20, 2026 at the latest.
- b. The Respondent will provide the documentary disclosure previously requested by the Applicant and in particular will provide the details of any commitments for refinancing.
- c. The Respondent shall not dispose of or encumber its assets without the consent of the Applicant or approval by the court pending the return of this matter.

- d. The parties will negotiate in good faith in an effort to reach a satisfactory agreement to retire the Applicant's loans and to pay its costs.

[4] Unless an agreement is reached or other circumstances arise to make the granting of a Receivership inappropriate, the parties may anticipate that an order substantially in the form of the draft, filed, will be made on March 17, 2026.
