

AFFIDAVIT OF PETER GOSSMANN

(sworn December 8, 2022)

I, Peter Gossmann, of the Community of Belle River in the Province of Ontario, **MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:**

1. I am a Director of 1731861 Ontario Inc. operating as Plasticap (the “**Plasticap**”), and as such have knowledge of the matters set out in this Affidavit.

1731861 ONTARIO INC., OPERATING AS PLASTICAP

2. 1731861 Ontario Inc. is an Ontario corporation whose shares are held by Thomas Lato (“**Lato**”) (80%) and Peter Gossmann (“**Gossmann**”) (20%).

11005855 CANADA INC.

3. 11005855 Canada Inc. (“**855 Canada**”) is a Federal Corporation whose shares are held by Lato (80%) and Gossmann (20%). Attached hereto as **Exhibit “1”** are the Certificate and Articles of Incorporation of 855 Canada.

SERENO HOLDINGS LLC

4. On or about July 18, 2018, Sereno Holdings LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, (“**Sereno Holdings**”) and 855 Canada entered into a Limited Liability Company Agreement and Declaration of Member of Sereno Holdings LLC (the “**Sereno LLC Agreement**”). A copy is attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit “2”**.

5. Lato is the President of Sereno Holdings.

6. The members of Sereno Holdings were Sereno Holdings and 855 Canada.

7. On or about April 1, 2020, 855 Canada, as Seller, and Lato, as Buyer, entered into a Membership Interest Purchase Agreement for the sale by 855 Canada of its interests in Sereno Holdings LLC to Lato. The interests of 855 Canada in Sereno Holdings LLC were sold to Lato to accommodate the request of US funders of the Polycap business who objected to one of the members being a Canadian corporation. A copy is attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit “3”**.

8. On or about February 22, 2019, Sereno Holdings received a Certificate of registration to transact business in Virginia. A copy is attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit “4”**.

9. Sereno LLC was created to be a holding company for the interests of Polycap and other plastics businesses, as those business opportunities arose. No other opportunities have arisen to date and there are no further subsidiary business interests held by Sereno Holdings at this time.

POLYCAP LLC

10. On or about July 19, 2018, Polycap LLC (“**Polycap**”) and Sereno Holdings entered into a Limited Liability Company Agreement and Declaration of Member of Polycap LLC (the “**Polycap LLC Agreement**”). A copy is attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit “5”**.
11. Sereno Holdings owns all of the interests of Polycap.
12. On or about February 22, 2019, Polycap received a Certificate of registration to transact business in Virginia. A copy is attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit “6”**.

ASSETS OF PLASTICAP; ASSETS OF POLYCAP

13. Attached hereto as **Exhibit “7”** is a listing of the equipment owned by Plasticap and the equipment owned by Polycap.
14. No security interest has been granted or, to my knowledge, claimed over the equipment and assets of Plasticap in the United States, other than the security interest claimed by RBC.
15. The Plasticap equipment and assets in the United States are located at 1050 Regional Park Road, Lebanon, VA 24266. The Plasticap equipment and assets is identifiable by its serial numbers and has not been intermingled with the assets of Polycap.
16. Attached hereto as **Exhibit “8”** is a copy of the Agreement pursuant to which Plasticap has assets Hawk Plastics Ltd. (“**Hawk**”) to permit Hawk to do subcontractor work on behalf of Plasticap.

REFINANCING EFFORTS

17. Plasticap has had discussions with BDC seeking to refinance its obligations to RBC.
18. Plasticap has had ongoing discussions with TD Bank seeking to refinance its obligations to RBC.
19. Plasticap has made inquiries of First Bank & Trust Company, a current funding source in Virginia, to seek financing to refinance its obligations to RBC.
20. Through counsel in the United States, Plasticap is seeking foreign investment to seek financing, and, among other things, refinance its obligations to RBC. Please find attached as **Exhibit “9”**, and email received from US Counsel.

DISCLOSURE TO RBC

21. Attached as **Exhibit "10"** is an email of Thursday, December 8, 2022, from the accountant to Plasticap setting out the disclosure requested by RBC Special Loans and the documents requested and delivered, or otherwise now attached in satisfaction of those requests.

2. Class B shareholders are entitled:

 - (b) To not vote at any meeting of shareholders, except as otherwise specifically provided in the Canada Business Corporations Act as amended from time to time.
3. Upon liquidation or dissolution the holders of Class A and Class B shares shall participate, share for share, in and receive the remaining property of the Corporation.
4. The Class B shares or any part thereof shall be redeemable at the option of the Corporation without the consent of the holders thereof at a price of \$10.00 per share plus any declared and unpaid dividends in respect of such shares.

**LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AGREEMENT
AND DECLARATION OF MEMBER OF**

SERENO HOLDINGS LLC

THIS LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AGREEMENT AND DECLARATION OF MEMBER (this "LLC Agreement") is made and entered into as of the 18th day of July, 2018, by and between **SERENO HOLDINGS LLC**, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Company"), and **11005855 CANADA INC.**, a Canadian corporation (the "Member"), as the sole member of the Company.

The parties agree as follows:

1. **Membership.** The Company's original member is 11005855 Canada Inc. The Company shall admit new members upon the written consent of all of the then-existing members. Before a new member is admitted, the Company shall provide the new member with a copy of this LLC Agreement, and the new member shall execute and deliver to the Company a signature page acknowledging that the new member agrees to be bound by the terms of this LLC Agreement. Matters requiring consent or approval of the members require an affirmative vote of a group of members whose Membership Interests (as defined in Section 4), if added together, would exceed 50% (such vote by the members, a "Controlling Majority Vote"), except as otherwise set forth in this LLC Agreement.
2. **Name; Business; Principal Place of Business.** The Company shall carry on business under the name of **SERENO HOLDINGS LLC**. The Company may engage in any lawful business permitted by Chapter 18 of the Delaware Limited Liability Company Act (the "Delaware LLC Act") or the laws of any jurisdiction in which the Company does business. The Company has the authority to do all things necessary or convenient to accomplish its purpose and operate its business as described in this Section 2. The principal office of the Company shall be located at such place as the Board shall determine from time to time. The Company may have such other offices as the members may designate or as the business of the Company may require.
3. **Duration.** The Company shall continue in existence until dissolved as provided in Section 11.
4. **Membership Contributions; Membership Interests.** Each member shall contribute cash or non-cash property to the Company (the "Membership Contributions") and, in consideration thereof, receive the percentage interest in the Company set forth opposite such member's name in Exhibit A (the "Membership Interests"). Membership Contributions exclude services provided to the Company. Except for the Membership Contributions, no member is obligated to contribute or otherwise to transfer to the Company any cash or non-cash property as consideration for such member's Membership Interest or for any other reason. Exhibit A is to be deemed revised at such time as any member is removed from, or any new member is added to, membership in the Company. Any new member shall make such Membership Contribution as is determined by the Board (as defined in Section 8) at the time of issuance of such new member's Membership Interest. Interest does not accrue on any Membership Contribution.

5. **Distributions.** The Company may distribute, from time to time and in its sole discretion, the profits of its business to each member in proportion of each such member's Membership Interest. The Company shall distribute such profits at such times and in such amounts as determined by the Board, provided the Company shall not make any distribution of Company profits to any member unless, after such proposed distribution, there remains property of the Company sufficient to pay the Company's liabilities.

6. **Books of Account and Company Records.** The Board is to furnish to any member, on request by such member, full information about any transaction and matter related to the Company, provided the Board is able to acquire such information without unreasonable effort or expense.

7. **Fiscal Year.** The Company's fiscal year is the calendar year.

8. **Management.**

A. **Selection of Managers.** The members may select managers of the Company by a Controlling Majority Vote. Managers can be, but do not have to be, members. The managers collectively constitute the "Board." The members may remove any manager or fill any vacancy on the Board by a Controlling Majority Vote. The members may increase or decrease the size of the Board at any time. The Board shall initially have one manager. Each manager is to serve until the earliest of such manager's death, disability, resignation or removal.

B. **Managers.** The Board has the authority to make all decisions concerning the business affairs of the Company, except as otherwise provided in this LLC Agreement or to the extent the Board delegates its authority to the officers as provided below. All such decisions are to be made by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board. The Board has the authority to bind the Company. The initial managers are:

Mr. Thomas Lato
Mr. Peter Gossman

C. **Selection of Officers.** The Company shall have the following officers: President, Secretary, Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board may elect. The same person may hold any two or more of the offices. Officers do not have to be members or managers. The Board may remove any officer by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board. Each officer is to serve until the earliest of such officer's death, disability, resignation or removal.

D. **Officers; Duties.** The officers have the authority to act for the Company in the ordinary course of the Company's business to the extent authorized by the Board. The initial officers are:

President – Mr. Thomas Lato

Treasurer/Secretary - Mr. Peter Gossmann

(i) The President is the chief executive officer of the Company and is responsible for the general administration of the Company's day-to-day affairs. The President is to generally operate the Company in the ordinary course of business subject to the direction of the Board and perform such other duties as the Board may require from time to time. Except as otherwise ordered by the Board, the President has general authority to execute on behalf of the Company any contracts, notes, deeds, and other papers or instruments not reserved by law or by the members or the managers as requiring specific action by such persons or specific action of another officer.

(ii) The Treasurer is to generally supervise all finances. The Treasurer is to receive and be in charge of all money, bills, notes, deeds, leases, mortgages, insurance policies, and similar property belonging to the Company and do with the same as the Board may require from time to time. The Treasurer is to keep adequate and correct accounts of the business transactions of the Company, including accounts of its assets, liabilities, receipts, disbursements, gains, losses, contributions, and distributions, together with such other accounts as may be required.

(iii) The Secretary is to keep a record of all proceedings and meetings of the members and perform such other duties as may be assigned to him or her by the members, the Board or the President.

E. **No Liability.** No manager or officer is liable for any error of judgment. Managers and officers are entitled to the full protections provided in the Delaware LLC Act in addition to any other protections provided in this LLC Agreement.

9. **Other Business Ventures.** The members, managers, and officers may engage in and own interests in any other business venture of any nature, and neither the Company nor any member, by virtue of this LLC Agreement, is to have any right in any such venture or the profits therefrom.

10. **Bank Account.** The Board is to designate and maintain the bank accounts of the Company.

11. **Dissolution.** The members may dissolve the Company by the unanimous written consent of all members. Upon dissolution of the Company, the Board is to liquidate the Company.

12. **Written Consent.** Any action required or permitted to be taken by the members or the Board at a meeting may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, is signed by all such members or the Board, respectively.

13. **Exculpation of Liability; Indemnification; Advance of Expenses**

A. A person who is a member, manager or officer is not liable for the acts, debts or liabilities of the Company, unless otherwise provided by law or expressly assumed in writing.

B. The Company shall indemnify and hold harmless any promoter, member, manager, officer, employee, or agent (the "Indemnified Person") who was or is a party or who is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending, or completed civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative action, suit, or proceeding, including an action or suit by or in the right of the Company to procure a judgment in its favor, because such Indemnified Person is or was a promoter, member, manager, officer, employee, or agent of the Company or is or was serving at the request of the Company as a member, shareholder, manager, director, trustee, officer, employee, or agent of another limited liability company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise, including without limitation all judgments, damages, fees, fines, penalties, charges, assessments, amounts paid in settlement, costs, and expenses (including without limitation reasonable attorney fees and costs of defense that were actually and reasonably incurred by the Indemnified Person in connection with the action, suit, or proceeding), provided such Indemnified Person acted in good faith and in a manner such Indemnified Person reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the Company and, in connection with any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe his, her, or its conduct was unlawful. The termination of any action, suit, or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, or conviction or upon a plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent does not create of itself (i) a presumption that the Indemnified Person did not act in good faith and in a manner such Indemnified Person reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the Company, or (ii) in connection with a criminal action or proceeding, a presumption that such Indemnified Person had reasonable cause to believe that such Indemnified Person's conduct was unlawful.

C. The indemnification provided by this Section 13 is not exclusive of any other right to which any person seeking indemnification may be entitled under the Articles of Organization, this LLC Agreement, or any agreement or vote of either the members or disinterested managers, or otherwise, both as to action in such person's official capacity and as to action in another capacity while holding such office, and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be a manager, officer, director, trustee, manager, officer, employee, or agent and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors, and administrators of such a person.

14. **Miscellaneous Provisions.**

A. If any provision of this LLC Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, all other provisions are to continue in full force and effect.

B. This LLC Agreement is to be construed and governed by Delaware law for all purposes. The Delaware LLC Act governs the Company, this LLC Agreement and the rights and liabilities of the members hereunder, except as otherwise provided in this LLC Agreement.

C. Failure to enforce any term or condition of this LLC Agreement does not constitute a waiver of that term or condition for the future, nor does any specific waiver of a term or condition at one time constitute a waiver of such term or condition for the future.

D. The members may lend money to and transact business with the Company and, except as otherwise provided by law, have the same rights and obligations with respect to loans and transactions as a person who is not a member.

E. This LLC Agreement is to inure to the benefit of, be binding upon and be enforceable by the heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the members, except as otherwise provided in this LLC Agreement.

F. This LLC Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes any prior oral or written agreement of the parties as to the subject-matter hereof. No modification or amendment of any provision of this LLC Agreement is effective unless the members approve by a Controlling Majority Vote.





MEMBERSHIP INTEREST PURCHASE AGREEMENT

THIS MEMBERSHIP INTEREST PURCHASE AGREEMENT (this "**Agreement**") is entered into as of the 1st day of April, 2020 (the "**Effective Date**"), by and between 11005855 CANADA INC. ("**Seller**") and THOMAS LATO ("**Buyer**") under the following circumstances:

A. Seller owns one hundred percent (100%) of the membership interest (the "**Interest**") of Sereno Holdings LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "**Company**"); and

B. Seller now desires to sell, and Buyer desires to purchase, the Interest according to the terms of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Sale of Interest.** Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Seller hereby sells and transfers the Interest to Buyer and Buyer hereby purchases the Interest from Seller.

2. **Purchase Price.** The total purchase price for the Interest shall be one dollar (\$1) (the "**Purchase Price**"), payable in full in cash at the Closing (as defined below).

3. **Closing Date.** The purchase and sale of the Interest (the "**Closing**") shall take place simultaneously with the execution of this Agreement.

4. **Joinder to Operating Agreement.** Buyer hereby agrees that upon the execution of this Agreement, he shall become a party to the Limited Liability Company Agreement and Declaration of Member of the Company, dated July 18, 2018 (the "**Operating Agreement**") and shall be fully bound by, and subject to, all of the covenants, terms and conditions of the Operating Agreement as though an original party thereto and shall be deemed to be a member of the Company for all purposes thereof.

5. **Governing Law.** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Delaware.

6. **Complete Agreement.** This Agreement, including all attachments, supersedes all prior agreements, written or oral, and is intended as a complete and exclusive statement of the terms of the agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.

**LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AGREEMENT
AND DECLARATION OF MEMBER OF**

POLYCAP LLC

THIS LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AGREEMENT AND DECLARATION OF MEMBER (this "LLC Agreement") is made and entered into as of the 19th day of July, 2018, by and between POLYCAP LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Company"), and SERENO HOLDINGS LLC., a Delaware corporation ("Sereno"), as the sole member of the Company.

The parties agree as follows:

1. **Membership.** The Company's original member is Sereno Holdings, LLC. The Company shall admit new members upon the written consent of all of the then-existing members. Before a new member is admitted, the Company shall provide the new member with a copy of this LLC Agreement, and the new member shall execute and deliver to the Company a signature page acknowledging that the new member agrees to be bound by the terms of this LLC Agreement. Matters requiring consent or approval of the members require an affirmative vote of a group of members whose Membership Interests (as defined in Section 4), if added together, would exceed 50% (such vote by the members, a "Controlling Majority Vote"), except as otherwise set forth in this LLC Agreement.

2. **Name; Business; Principal Place of Business.** The Company shall carry on business under the name of POLYCAP LLC. The Company may engage in any lawful business permitted by Chapter 18 of the Delaware Limited Liability Company Act (the "Delaware LLC Act") or the laws of any jurisdiction in which the Company does business. The Company has the authority to do all things necessary or convenient to accomplish its purpose and operate its business as described in this Section 2. The principal office of the Company shall be located at such place as the Board shall determine from time to time. The Company may have such other offices as the members may designate or as the business of the Company may require.

3. **Duration.** The Company shall continue in existence until dissolved as provided in Section 11.

4. **Membership Contributions; Membership Interests.** Each member shall contribute cash or non-cash property to the Company (the "Membership Contributions") and, in consideration thereof, receive the percentage interest in the Company set forth opposite such member's name in Exhibit A (the "Membership Interests"). Membership Contributions exclude services provided to the Company. Except for the Membership Contributions, no member is obligated to contribute or otherwise to transfer to the Company any cash or non-cash property as consideration for such member's Membership Interest or for any other reason. Exhibit A is to be deemed revised at such time as any member is removed from, or any new member is added to, membership in the Company. Any new member shall make such Membership Contribution as is determined by the Board (as defined in Section 8) at the time of issuance of such new member's Membership Interest. Interest does not accrue on any Membership Contribution.

5. **Distributions.** The Company may distribute, from time to time and in its sole discretion, the profits of its business to each member in proportion of each such member's Membership Interest. The Company shall distribute such profits at such times and in such amounts as determined by the Board, provided the Company shall not make any distribution of Company profits to any member unless, after such proposed distribution, there remains property of the Company sufficient to pay the Company's liabilities.

6. **Books of Account and Company Records.** The Board is to furnish to any member, on request by such member, full information about any transaction and matter related to the Company, provided the Board is able to acquire such information without unreasonable effort or expense.

7. **Fiscal Year.** The Company's fiscal year is the calendar year.

8. **Management.**

A. **Selection of Managers.** The members may select managers of the Company by a Controlling Majority Vote. Managers can be, but do not have to be, members. The managers collectively constitute the "Board." The members may remove any manager or fill any vacancy on the Board by a Controlling Majority Vote. The members may increase or decrease the size of the Board at any time. The Board shall initially have one manager. Each manager is to serve until the earliest of such manager's death, disability, resignation or removal.

B. **Managers.** The Board has the authority to make all decisions concerning the business affairs of the Company, except as otherwise provided in this LLC Agreement or to the extent the Board delegates its authority to the officers as provided below. All such decisions are to be made by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board. The Board has the authority to bind the Company. The initial managers are:

Mr. Thomas Lato
Mr. Peter Gossman

C. **Selection of Officers.** The Company shall have the following officers: President, Secretary, Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board may elect. The same person may hold any two or more of the offices. Officers do not have to be members or managers. The Board may remove any officer by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board. Each officer is to serve until the earliest of such officer's death, disability, resignation or removal.

D. **Officers; Duties.** The officers have the authority to act for the Company in the ordinary course of the Company's business to the extent authorized by the Board. The initial officers are:

President – Mr. Thomas Lato

Treasurer/Secretary - Mr. Peter Gossman

(i) The President is the chief executive officer of the Company and is responsible for the general administration of the Company's day-to-day affairs. The President is to generally operate the Company in the ordinary course of business subject to the direction of the Board and perform such other duties as the Board may require from time to time. Except as otherwise ordered by the Board, the President has general authority to execute on behalf of the Company any contracts, notes, deeds, and other papers or instruments not reserved by law or by the members or the managers as requiring specific action by such persons or specific action of another officer.

(ii) The Treasurer is to generally supervise all finances. The Treasurer is to receive and be in charge of all money, bills, notes, deeds, leases, mortgages, insurance policies, and similar property belonging to the Company and do with the same as the Board may require from time to time. The Treasurer is to keep adequate and correct accounts of the business transactions of the Company, including accounts of its assets, liabilities, receipts, disbursements, gains, losses, contributions, and distributions, together with such other accounts as may be required.

(iii) The Secretary is to keep a record of all proceedings and meetings of the members and perform such other duties as may be assigned to him or her by the members, the Board or the President.

E. **No Liability.** No manager or officer is liable for any error of judgment. Managers and officers are entitled to the full protections provided in the Delaware LLC Act in addition to any other protections provided in this LLC Agreement.

9. **Other Business Ventures.** The members, managers, and officers may engage in and own interests in any other business venture of any nature, and neither the Company nor any member, by virtue of this LLC Agreement, is to have any right in any such venture or the profits therefrom.

10. **Bank Account.** The Board is to designate and maintain the bank accounts of the Company.

11. **Dissolution.** The members may dissolve the Company by the unanimous written consent of all members. Upon dissolution of the Company, the Board is to liquidate the Company.

12. **Written Consent.** Any action required or permitted to be taken by the members or the Board at a meeting may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, is signed by all such members or the Board, respectively.

13. **Exculpation of Liability; Indemnification; Advance of Expenses**

A. A person who is a member, manager or officer is not liable for the acts, debts or liabilities of the Company, unless otherwise provided by law or expressly assumed in writing.

B. The Company shall indemnify and hold harmless any promoter, member, manager, officer, employee, or agent (the "Indemnified Person") who was or is a party or who is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending, or completed civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative action, suit, or proceeding, including an action or suit by or in the right of the Company to procure a judgment in its favor, because such Indemnified Person is or was a promoter, member, manager, officer, employee, or agent of the Company or is or was serving at the request of the Company as a member, shareholder, manager, director, trustee, officer, employee, or agent of another limited liability company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise, including without limitation all judgments, damages, fees, fines, penalties, charges, assessments, amounts paid in settlement, costs, and expenses (including without limitation reasonable attorney fees and costs of defense that were actually and reasonably incurred by the Indemnified Person in connection with the action, suit, or proceeding), provided such Indemnified Person acted in good faith and in a manner such Indemnified Person reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the Company and, in connection with any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe his, her, or its conduct was unlawful. The termination of any action, suit, or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, or conviction or upon a plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent does not create of itself (i) a presumption that the Indemnified Person did not act in good faith and in a manner such Indemnified Person reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the Company, or (ii) in connection with a criminal action or proceeding, a presumption that such Indemnified Person had reasonable cause to believe that such Indemnified Person's conduct was unlawful.

C. The indemnification provided by this Section 13 is not exclusive of any other right to which any person seeking indemnification may be entitled under the Articles of Organization, this LLC Agreement, or any agreement or vote of either the members or disinterested managers, or otherwise, both as to action in such person's official capacity and as to action in another capacity while holding such office, and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be a manager, officer, director, trustee, manager, officer, employee, or agent and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors, and administrators of such a person.

14. **Miscellaneous Provisions.**

A. If any provision of this LLC Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, all other provisions are to continue in full force and effect.

B. This LLC Agreement is to be construed and governed by Delaware law for all purposes. The Delaware LLC Act governs the Company, this LLC Agreement and the rights and liabilities of the members hereunder, except as otherwise provided in this LLC Agreement.

C. Failure to enforce any term or condition of this LLC Agreement does not constitute a waiver of that term or condition for the future, nor does any specific waiver of a term or condition at one time constitute a waiver of such term or condition for the future.

D. The members may lend money to and transact business with the Company and, except as otherwise provided by law, have the same rights and obligations with respect to loans and transactions as a person who is not a member.

E. This LLC Agreement is to inure to the benefit of, be binding upon and be enforceable by the heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the members, except as otherwise provided in this LLC Agreement.



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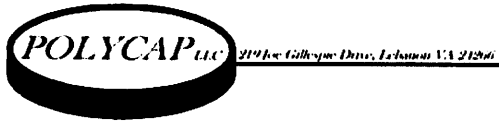

SUBCONTRACTOR AGREEMENT





SUBCONTRACTOR AGREEMENT

This Agreement, as negotiated herein, is entered into by and between Hawk Plastics Ltd. at Oldcastle, Ontario, "Subcontractor" and 1731861 Ontario Inc. (Plasticap) at Concord, Ontario, "Contractor." For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Subcontractor and the Contractor hereby agree as follows:

Article 1. Statement of Work:

From time to time, Subcontractor may provide services to Contractor. In addition to the terms and conditions negotiated by the parties for particular projects, Contractor and Subcontractor hereby agree that the terms and conditions of this Subcontractor Agreement (the "Agreement") shall apply whenever Subcontractor provides services to Contractor. In general, the Subcontractor is to provide labor, and overhead costs as well as internal handling. Pricing to be negotiated on a project by project basis. The contractor is to provide tooling, ancillary equipment, materials and packaging to produce contractors products.

Article 2. Insurance:

The Subcontractor, at its own expense, shall obtain and maintain in full force and effect, without interruption during the term of the Agreement, the following minimum levels of insurance:

A. Workers' Compensation insurance covering the legal liability of the Contractor and its Subcontractors under the applicable workers' compensation or occupational disease laws for claims for personal injuries and death resulting there from to the Contractor and its Subcontractor's employees. The Subcontractor shall also obtain a minimum of \$500,000 of Employers' Liability insurance. Certificates of insurance must include a waiver of subrogation in favor of Contractor.

B. Commercial General Liability insurance covering the legal liability (including liability assumed contractually, whether incidental or not) of the Subcontractor who may be engaged in the services, for claims for personal injuries (including death) and property damage resulting there from arising out of the services to be performed by the Subcontractor, in an amount not less than \$500,000 for any one occurrence, \$1,000,000 general aggregate (subject to a per project general aggregate provision), \$1,000,000 Products/Completed Operations aggregate limit. Commercial General Liability insurance shall be obtained and shall include broad form contractual liability coverage, products/completed operations, cross liability, severability of interest and broad form property damage (if required), and Contractor as well as its directors, officers and employees shall be named as an additional insured on such Commercial General Liability policy regarding liability arising out of operations performed under this Agreement.

Article 3. Indemnification and Arbitration:

The work performed by the Subcontractor shall be at the risk of the Subcontractor exclusively. Subcontractor hereby indemnifies and holds Contractor, its parent and affiliates and their respective officers, directors, employees and agents, harmless from and against any and all claims, actions, losses, judgments, or expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising from or in any way

connected with the work performed, materials furnished, or services provided to Contractor during the term of this Agreement. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or the breach thereof, shall be settled by binding arbitration and judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. The prevailing party in any arbitration concerning this Agreement shall be entitled to reasonable attorneys' fees.

Article 4. Warranty:

Subcontractor warrants its work for a period of one year against all defects in workmanship.
Contractor warrants its part for a period of one year against all defects in materials and packaging.

Article 5. Miscellaneous:


Subcontractor is an independent contractor and not an employee of Contractor.
This Agreement shall be in full force and effect from the date of signing for 5 years unless canceled in writing by either party with thirty (30) days' written notice. The cancellation of this Agreement shall not negate any term or condition, such as the indemnity or insurance requirements.

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario. Any amendment(s) must be given in writing.
