#### **ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE STEELE:**

- 1. Motion by RBC for an order appointing msi Spergel Inc. as receiver over all of the assets of Vellend-Tech.
- 2. The motion is unopposed.
- 3. Vellend-Tech is indebted to RBC in connection with certain credit facilities advanced by RBC under various credit agreements. The Company granted RBC a general security agreement (the "GSA"), registration in respect of which was duly made pursuant to the *Personal Property Security Act* (Ontario). RBC is the first-ranking registered secured party as against the Company.
- 4. Section 13 of the GSA provides for the appointment of a receiver upon default.
- 5. On or about April 26, 2022 RBC made formal written demand on Vellend-Tech. At that time RBC also issued a Notice of Intention to Enforce Security pursuant to s. 244 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.
- 6. The parties subsequently entered into a forbearance agreement pursuant to which Vellend-Tech was to repay all indebtedness by April 20, 2023, failing which RBC would be entitled to enforce a consent to receivership and a consent to judgment.
- 7. On April 20, 2023 the Company advised RBC that it is unable to repay the indebtedness.
- 8. The requested Order is consistent with the Commercial List Model Order.
- 9. I am satisfied that it is appropriate in this case to appoint a receiver.
- 10. Order to go in accordance with the attached.
