AFFIDAVIT OF SANDEEP (SUNNY) SINGH

(Affirmed October 7th, 2025)

- I, SANDEEP (SUNNY) SINGH, of the City of Mississauga, in the Province of Ontario, AFFIRM AND SAY:
- 1. I am the President and principal of the Respondents 8777691 Canada Inc. ("Panjaab Transport") and 2747826 Ontario Inc. ("274"). As such, I have knowledge of the matters to which I hereinafter depose. Where I do not have personal knowledge of the matters set out herein below, I have been advised of the source of my information and, in all such cases, I believe it to be true.

- 2. I make this affidavit in response to the Application of the Applicant ("RBC") and specifically, its request for the appointment of a Receiver over, and with respect to, the assets, undertakings and properties of Panjaab Transport and 274.
- 3. While I do not fully agree with the characterization of the operations and circumstances surrounding 274 and Panjaab Transport as set out in the September 18, 2025 affidavit of Adam Haugh ("Haugh Affidavit"), I acknowledge that 274 and Panjaab Transport unfortunately, but not intentionally, are currently off-side of their obligations under the Credit Agreements, as defined in the Haugh Affidavit.
- 4. With that said, I come before this Honourable Court asking for an opportunity to save my companies which I have built from the ground up, and the livelihood of approximately 140 individuals who work with, and/or for Panjaab Transport. I ask that I and the Respondents be afforded a short period of time (120 days) to execute our funding efforts as further described below to payout the RBC debt before the appointment of the Receiver, beyond its current interim status.

BACKGROUND ON THE RESPONDENTS

5. Founded in 2014, Panjaab Transport is a logistics, trucking and transport company based in Oakville, Ontario. The company specializes in flatbed freight and car hauling services, with more than 90 operational trucks hauling freight over 80 routes, throughout Canada and the United States. Panjaab Transport hauls a wide range of products, including, but not limited to, lumber, aluminum, machinery, vehicles and hazmat material. Excerpts from our website which

describe who we are, and what we do, are attached as **Exhibit "A"**. The articles of incorporation for Panjaab Transport are found at Exhibit "A" of the Haugh Affidavit.

- 6. Panjaab Transport employes over 80 staff members, and works with more than 60-plus contractors, including office staff, mechanics, security personnel, and drivers. Collectively we support the livelihood of approximately 140 individuals and their families, who depend on us. This includes my dependent family, consisting of my wife, my parents, my grandmother and my sister-in-law, who all live with me.
- 7. Up until 2025, Panjaab Transport has been growing, not only in terms of operational size, but its revenues. For fiscal year ending January 31, 2025, Panjaab Transport's annual revenue was more than \$36 million, up from approximately \$28 million from the previous year-end. Attached as **Exhibit "B"** is a copy of Panjaab Transport's 2025 financial statements.
- 8. 274 is what you can describe as the sibling corporation to Panjaab Transport, which owns and manages two trucking yards 2213 Ninth Line and 2101 Nine Line, both located in Oakville, Ontario. Attached as Exhibit "B" to the Haugh Affidavit is the articles of incorporation for 274. The parcel abstracts for these two properties are found at Exhibit "L" of the Haugh Affidavit.

PLAN TO PAY OFF RBC'S DEBT

9. The Respondents are not looking, at this time, to challenge the appointment of the Interim Receiver, nor seeks its removal.

- 10. The Respondents are asking for a window of 120 days to pay off the outstanding monies due and owing to RBC (the "Funding Window"), to preserve its business and assets. The Respondents will not object to the maintenance of the Interim Receiver during the Funding Window, if this Honourable Court is inclined to maintain said Interim Receiver.
- 11. I have been actively taking steps to come up with money to pay off RBC's debt. Currently, I am pursuing the following funding avenues, which I am asking for the opportunity to execute.
- 12. Panjaab Transport has obtained a \$5,000,000.00 term sheet from Rev Capital for a factoring facility with respect to Panjaab Transport's outstanding accounts receivables. Based on my current discussions with Jon Turner, Senior Director Business Development at Rev Capital, I understand that funding can be delivered within 120 days. A copy of the Rev Capital term sheet, and an October 6, 2025 email correspondence from Jon Turner to me, are attached as **Exhibit "C"**.
- 13. Further, I have also been in discussions with Kingsett Mortgage Corporation ("Kingsett") about obtaining a \$8 million dollar mortgage from them. A copy of the Letter of Intent from Kingsett is attached as **Exhibit "D"**.
- 14. With the help of Gordon Valko, a corporate financing consultant, and his company Enfield Capital Corp., I have submitted an application to Pathward for a \$5,000,000.00 \$CDN line of credit and approximate \$1,000,000.00 \$USD line of credit. Attached as **Exhibit "E"** is a copy off Panjaab's Transport's application to Pathward as well as an October 7, 2025 email from Mr. Valko indicating that a term sheet from Pathward should be received either same day of his email, or the following day.

- 15. Furthermore, I have also been working with Sanjay Yaddehige at Patvia Consulting, and together, we have been working with CIBC to get a funding term sheet from this bank. Attached as **Exhibit "F"** are email correspondence between, *inter alia*, myself, Mr. Yaddehige, and Matthew Little, Director of Commercial Banking, Southwest Ontario, CIBC, evidencing our current efforts to get funding from CIBC. I am working with Chartered Accountant Pal Ghumman of Affinity LLP, located in Mississauga, to secure a line of credit from TD Canada Trust and/or a mortgage from the Business Development Bank of Canada. The TD representative we are dealing with is Kapil Kwatra.
- 16. In addition to all of the above funding efforts, I have listed the following properties for sale:
 - a) My personal residence, being 21 Bowman Avenue, Brampton, Ontario. The property is listed at \$3,499,000.00, and carries a CIBC mortgage in the amount of approximately \$2,000,000.00. Attached as **Exhibit "G"** is the realtor.ca MLS listing for the property.
 - b) The 2213 Ninth Line and 2101 Nine Line properties, for \$7,799,000.00 and \$8,999,999.00 respectively. Attached as **Exhibit "G"** are the realtor.ca MLS listing for the properties. 2213 Ninth Line has an RBC mortgage in the amount of \$3.2 million. 2101 Ninth Line has an RBC mortgage in the amount of \$5.4 million.
- 17. In addition to the foregoing, Panjaab Transport is currently involved in an HST audit with Canada Revenue Agency ("CRA"). At the moment, we are owed, and expect, an HST refund from CRA in the amount of \$4.2 million for 2024. During a September 15, 2025 call I had with a CRA representative, I was advised that CRA was prepared to pay Panjaab Transport \$1.8 million to settle our refund for 2024, as

at that time CRA was not prepared to acknowledge the balance without additional document/information verification. We are still negotiating with CRA, and sent them additional documentation and information to address the \$2.4 million that is currently not being accepted by CRA.

- 18. There is/will be also another HST refund of approximately \$3 million due and owing to Panjaab Transport for 2025, which I anticipate will be paid after the 2024 audit is completed.
- 19. Panjaab Transport expects to receive its CRA HST refund within 30 days of resolution of the matter, which resolution we expect/hope shortly.
- 20. Based on the foregoing, I am making a concerted effort, through multiple avenues to come up with the money to pay back RBC. I am asking for the opportunity to see these efforts through.

INTERM RECEIVER

- 21. I remain committed, and understand, that the Respondents are expected to work with the Interim Receiver during the Funding Window, if so granted. In regards to the issue of providing the Interim Receiver with access to financial documentation and information, as I have advised the Interim Receiver, the Respondents have been locked out of access to our Quickbooks.
- 22. We started using Quickbooks in August 2024. The account was opened by our then accountant Lakhvir Singh, under his name. Mr. Singh left our company on contentious terms in July 2025, without leaving us with the account password, which is unknown to me and anyone else at Quickbooks. Mr. Singh has not been co-operative with providing us with the password and/or access to Quickbooks and

I and my staff have not had success in securing access to our account in our discussions with Quickbooks. I remain committed in trying to obtain access to our Quickbooks and providing access to the Interim Receiver.

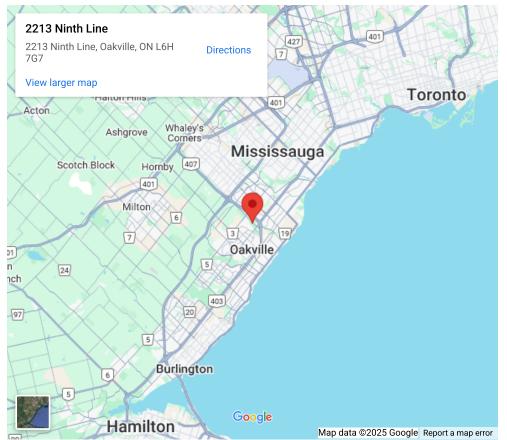

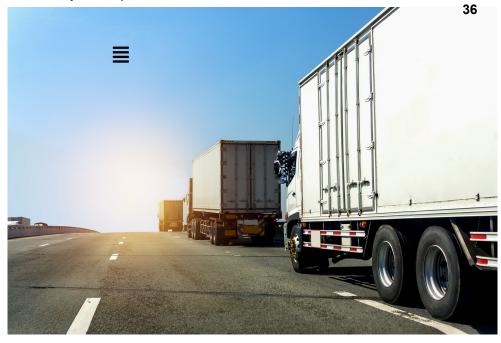

Notes to Financial Statements Year ended January 31, 2025 (Unaudited)

1. Nature of operations

8777691 Canada Inc. was incorporated under the Canada Business Corporations Act on February 3, 2014. The Company primarily earns income from logistics and transportation specializing in flatbed trucking.

2. Summary of significant accounting policies

These financial statements are prepared in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for private enterprises. The significant accounting policies are detailed as follows:

Use of estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with Canadian accounting standards for private enterprises requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the balance sheet date and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the year. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Areas requiring estimates include valuation of accounts receivable, the life of property and equipment, accounts payable and accrued liabilities.

Revenue recognition

The Company recognizes revenue, when specifically, all of the following conditions are met:

- there is persuasive evidence that an arrangement exists,
- services has been provided,
- the price is fixed or determinable,
- collection is reasonably assured, and
- goods are shipped to the satisfaction of the customer.

<u>Leases</u>

Leases are classified as either capital or operating leases. Leases that transfer substantially all of the benefits and inherent risks of ownership of property to the Company are accounted for as capital leases. At the time a capital lease is entered into, an asset is recorded together with its related long-term obligation to reflect the acquisition and financing. Equipment recorded under capital leases is amortized on the same basis as described above. Payments under operating leases are expensed as incurred.

Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are recorded at cost and are being amortized over their estimated useful lives. The annual amortization rates are as follows:

Amortization of leasehold improvements is recorded over the remaining term of the lease plus the first renewal option.

Property, plant and equipment are reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in the circumstances indicate that the carrying value may not be recoverable. If the total of the estimated undiscounted future cash flows is less than the carrying value of the asset, an impairment loss is recognized for the excess of the carrying value over the fair value of the asset during the year the impairment occurs.

Notes to Financial Statements Year ended January 31, 2025 (Unaudited)

2. Summary of significant accounting policies — continued

Income taxes

The Company accounts for income taxes using the taxes payable method. The taxes payable and provision for income taxes are based on the corporate income tax returns filed. There is no adjustment for income taxes related to temporary differences and no recognition of the benefit of income tax losses carried forward.

Foreign exchange

Monetary assets and liabilities of the Company which are denominated in foreign currencies are translated at year end exchange rates. Non-monetary assets and liabilities are translated at rates in effect at the date the assets were acquired and liabilities incurred. Revenue and expenses are translated at the rates of exchange in effect at their transaction dates. The resulting gains or losses are included in operations.

Financial instruments

(i) Measurement of financial instruments

The Company initially measures its financial assets and financial liabilities at fair value adjusted by, in the case of a financial instrument that will not be measured subsequently at fair value, the amount of transaction costs directly attributable to the instrument. Amounts due to and from related parties are measured at the exchange amount, being the amount agreed upon by the related parties.

Financial assets measured at amortized cost include accounts receivable, and HST receivable.

Financial liabilities measured at amortized cost include the bank indebtedness, accounts payable and accrued liabilities, income taxes payable, obligations under capital leases and bank loan payable. Loans to or from related parties are carried at the exchange amount as noted above.

(ii) <u>Impair</u>ment

Financial assets measured at amortized cost are tested for impairment when there are indicators of possible impairment. When a significant adverse change has occurred during the period in the expected timing or amount of future cash flows from the financial asset or group of assets, a write-down is recognized in net income.

3. Due from/to related parties

Amounts due to (from) related parties are non interest bearing with no specific terms of repayment. The loans are classified as long term on representations from each party that payment will not be demanded within the next twelve month's. The companies are considered related because of common ownership by family members.

13. Financial instruments

Transactions in financial instruments may result in an entity assuming or transferring to another party one or more of the financial risks described below. The Company is not exposed to significant other price risks. There have been no significant changes in risk exposure since the prior year.

Currency risk

Credit risk
