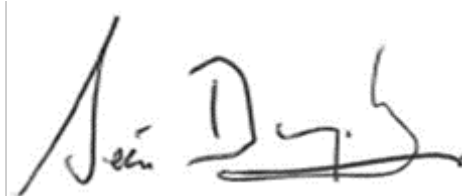

ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE:

- [1] This motion to appoint a receiver was adjourned last week to permit the parties to negotiate the interplay between the proposed receiver and its authority vis a vis Bridgestone who has prior ranking security to the applicant bank on certain inventory supplied by it.
